CATASTROPHE HITS

The 2006 Devonshire Apartments Fire in Bloomington, MN, resulted in extensive damage to the complex. The fire was caused by a single cigarette that was improperly disposed of, and the resulting fire fully destroyed one of buildings in the complex.

A total of 78 apartments were affected. Many units were completely destroyed by the fire, while others sustained significant smoke and water damage. The extent of the destruction rendered several units uninhabitable.

The fire caused severe structural damage to the building. The combination of fire, smoke, and water from firefighting efforts led to the building being deemed unsafe for occupancy. Parts of the structure had to be demolished and rebuilt.
